Policy for UK	 Online survey conducted 22 January – 8 February 2016 simultaneously
Policy at EU Level	 Detailed stratification process (sex, age, region, education, income)
Civic processes	 Good demographic representation, some weighting to adjust for deviations from population data
	 Overrepresentation of voters (EP elections), but limited effect on results in sensitivity checks
Discussion	 Master questionnaire developed in English with multiple iterations and expert feedback and detailed translation process


